Maintaining balance in 3 main currencies ensures no foreign exchange risk. I do not attempt to "time" the market.

Instead we retain cash in any major currency that we have costs in - so we have appropriate balances to cover costs when due.

Much of the £ & € renewals are done face to face for zero or minimal transaction cost.

Our main UK expenditure is postage, however the majority of 2016 costs have fallen into 2017.

Overall outgoings matched subscriptions (when including all postage).

Negative balance of the first 5 NAFCs is inclusive of £525 spent on long-term boards.

The last couple of NAFCs have caused a loss. The 2017 NAFC is on target to at least break even.

All "payments out" include transaction charges. All "payment in" is net of any transaction charge.

I am happy that this represents the income and expenditure of NAF for 2016.
