Maintaining balance in 3 main currencies ensures no foreign exchange risk. I do not attempt to "time" the market.

Instead we retain cash in any major currency that we have costs in - so we have appropriate balances to cover costs when due.

Much of the £ & € renewals are done face to face for zero or minimal transaction cost.

Negative balance of the first 4 NAFCs is inclusive of £525 spent on long-term boards. Should be spread over all NAFCs, not just the first 4.

Negative balance of last NAFC was due to late lower attendance & raised fixed (food) costs.

Food dropped for 2016 and contract to be considered for 2017 with intention for event to run at cost.

Overall outgoings matched subscriptions. Mainly down to much higher postage costs (and reduced fees for FTF renewal) for 2015.

All "payments out" include transaction charges. All "payment in" is net of any transaction charge.

I am happy that this represents the income and expenditure of NAF for 2015.
