Membership numbers of 3085 for the year. Compared with 1570 in 2009, then 1863, 1961, 2216, 2106, 1879, 2096 and then 2225 in 2016.

Maintaining balance in 3 main currencies ensures no foreign exchange risk. I do not attempt to "time" the market.

Instead we retain cash in any major currency that we have costs in - so we have appropriate balances to cover costs when due.

Much of the £ & € renewals are done face to face for zero or minimal transaction cost.

\$ subs are mostly directly from website. Most of the € subs are included in the £ subs due to autoconvert

Overall net outgoings mostly matched net subscriptions.

US postage costs were no higher this year, however due to a change in practice, two years of expenses are included above

The year's payments in excess of income went to WC IV (€8k loan) and Wales EB (£8k loan) and website development.

Website development was the big spend of the year - and was much needed. It included:

\*Critical site overhaul of signing up and renewal and a lot of technical work in the background Zikula platform

\*Improved functionality re multiple complementary rankings and alternative sorting methods .

\*The ability to show or hide real names in relation to GDPR changes.

\*Additional races, coach summaries/awards and tournament summaries

\*Improvements to nation listings (residence and domicile)

\*This was budgeted for 800 hours of work and paid for in instalments as work progressed.

\*Cosmetic changes are also intended, to improve the look of the website - as opposed to just technical work.

The last NAFC reversed the trend of small losses. The 2018 NAFC is on target to at least break even.

All "payments out" include transaction charges. All "payment in" is net of any transaction charge.
