Ramtut III may be the fearsome captain of the Champions of Death and hold a host of league records, but did you know he's going to be making a new kind of record in 2490? Yes, the desiccated destroyer has invented a completely new genre of music called 'Wrapping'. Over the summer he played several festivals and received rave reviews. Talent scouts are now raiding tombs in Nehekhara hoping to uncover more Wrappers.

Ramtut is not an isolated case either, more and more of the NAF's star players are cashing in on their sporting fame by starting second careers in show business. Last summer, the Bluebay Crammers muscular lineman Arfie Shortzenegger moved to the enchanted Wood Elf realm of Holly Wood, hoping to make a name for himself as an actor, so far, though, he's only managed to co-

found a restaurant called Plant-it Holly Wood.

This is all a far cry from the situation players faced only 20 years ago. Back then, the employment prospects for retired Blood Bowl players were unremittingly bleak. 




