Fighting Like Cornered Rats

After the off-field drama of Coach Vytick's partial beheading, the Scramblers showed an immediate improvement. After weeks of their fans calling for their coach and players to be executed, it was a novelty to see the Skaven on the field execute every play to perfection.
