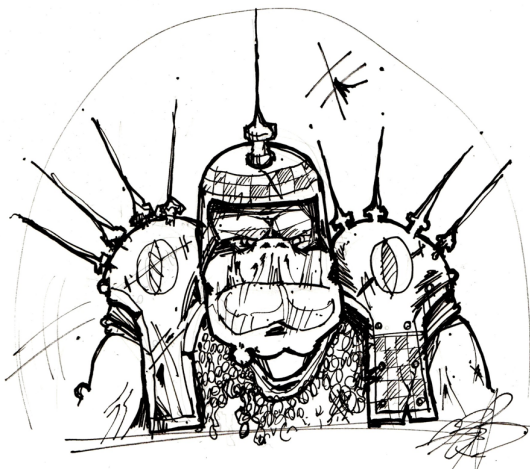

Even now, when the Gougued Eye play any Dwarf team, sooner or later the famous chant will rise from their screaming fans; *He's big, he's ace, he's going to punch your face; BOLG BOLG BOLG! BOLG BOLG BOLG!* But for those younger fans who perhaps never saw the legendary Orc in action, who was Bolg Stonemangle, and how did he earn the title of 'Dwarfmangle?'

Bolg was an Orc Blitzter spotted by the Gougued Eye after captain Hurk Verminsmasher saw the enthusiastic rookie flatten two of his own teammates in his desire to score a touchdown in a reserve game. Impressing the coaches, Bolg soon found himself making his first team debut, and the fans were astonished to see that the massive orc could actually handle the ball; Bolg caught a loose pass before enthusiastically driving the spiked ball into an unfortunate elf who tried to stop his lumbering run towards the endzone. Both elf and ball were plunged triumphantly into the endzone turf in a bloody smear, and a legend was born. A young Varag Ghou-Chewer was rumoured to be in the stands that day, and if so, the future star clearly took his inspiration from Bolg.

Bolg Stonemangle was top scorer for the Gougued Eye in the 2464 season, finishing the season with a flourish by an appearance in Blood Bowl IV, playing a heavily backed Dwarf Giants team in the final. It was to be the finest game of Bolg's career; the dwarves were annihilated in a brutal game, Bolg scoring a hat trick of touch downs and taking the match ball (plus several dwarf beards) home with him. The fans nickname of Dwarfmangle stuck after that; Bolg never bothered to learn how to spell his name anyway so happily took on the new title.

By the time of Blood Bowl XIII Bolg was the wily veteran rather than the young star but while not making it onto the scoresheet this time, his fearsome reputation undoubtedly unsettled the Dwarf Warhammerers and saw Bolg winning his second championship with the Gougued Eye. Few who saw that game could forget the sight of Dwarf Runner Grungi Spikebeard tripping over his own beard in his (useless) attempt to flee from Bolg.

Bolg Dwarfmangle retired the following season, his testimonial match against the reluctant Dwarf Giants (tempted only by the extremely large sack of gold promised to them) proving a surprisingly even tempered affair with only 3 deaths on the pitch; a record low for the Gougued Eye that season.

Since playing his last game, despite numerous lucrative offers to tempt him out of retirement or into the dugout as a coach, Bolg Dwarfmangle has resisted in favour of mixing up 'Bolg's Brew'; a potent fungus beer which promises that the drinkers sight and sense of taste almost always return after a week.

Perhaps unsurprisingly, wooden mugs (the beer unfortunately melted metal tankards) of Bolg's Brew are a perennial favourite of the more hardcore Gougued Eye fans at games.

And whenever the Gougued Eye play a dwarf team, you can guarantee that Bolg Dwarfmangler will be sat in the stands, glaring and growling fiercely at the opposition, wrapped in his dwarf beard cloak with a mug of Bolg's Brew clutched in one hand.

STAR Spotlight

Egon Saintlyburg

The Bright Crusaders have a famously strict recruitment policy, they will only sign players that are devout worshippers of the Church of Nuffle, over the years this insistence on theological purity has cost them many games and a fair few great players. Who can forget that in the Crush of 2483, they actually had the first refusal on the Dark Elf superstar Hubris Rakarth. The deal collapsed when Rakarth failed his interview with the Crusaders' elderly founder Ingrid the Pious. When he was asked 'what he thought of the Holy Book of Nuffle?', Hubris's answer was "It's great, I use it instead of coal to keep the furnace in my torture chamber burning, there's so many pages, it stays alight for days!"

On the rare occasions a true believer is available in the Crush, the Crusaders bend over backwards to get the rookie's signature. The most recent example came in this year's Crush, when the highly rated (and piously devout) Thrower Egon Saintlyburg became available. To everyone's surprise, Saintlyburg took a wrong turn as he exited the famous door and inexplicably ended up in the arms of the Evil Gits' head coach Bargull Whipdeath. Egon instantly realised he'd made a huge mistake. This was confirmed when Whipdeath's first words to his new recruit were, "Aw, no! It's that *&\$@ing bible basher!"

The first day of training was a disaster. Upon his arrival, his new team-mates chuckled with contempt at Saintlyburg's conservative dress sense, and his T-Shirt which had the religious slogan "Won't Score 'Till I'm Married," on the front. By mid-morning, they

were positively fuming at the fact his library of religious texts had taken up half the locker room. But by the afternoon, they were driven to a homicidal rage by Egon's requests for them to 'pray with him', as he tried, ever more unsubtly, to convert them.

By the end of the day, the players confronted coach Whipdeath, threatening to go on strike unless the God-fearing rookie was traded away immediately. Whipdeath, who was also thoroughly sick of Saintlyburg's nauseating moralising, knew exactly what to do, and a trade with the Bright Crusaders was arranged with such haste, that Saintlyburg was an Evil Git for less than 24 hours.
