Merciless Killers Set Up Title Decider.

Khain's Killers have given themselves a golden opportunity to win the AFC East divisional title after a hard fought win against the Bright Crusaders. Hard running Blitzer Crou Nightshade was yet again the Killers hero as he amassed 83 paces and 2 Touchdowns. With results going in their favour they now face a 'winner takes all' showdown against the Chaos All-Stars next week. It's been reported that they've invested in 20 new altars to accommodate all the extra blood sacrifices they'll be making prior to the match.

Oberwald Breaks the Crescents

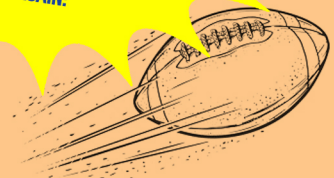

SOCK IT TO ME!

IT'S THE BIZARRE RITUAL THAT DECIDES EVERY TEAM'S SCHEDULE.

Sports KILLERSTRATED REPORTS BACK ON THIS YEAR'S SOCK EXCHANGE...



The cavernous hall is a scene of utter mayhem. countless bodies jostle and clash, a cacophony of guttural shouts echo deafeningly around the vast auditorium and the unmistakable odour of stale footwear hangs in the air like some malevolent spirit.

Out of the mayhem, an imperious Elf Maiden strides forth. Her quarry sighted; the seething crowd magically parts as she moves with supernatural grace towards the wretched green figure skulking in the corner. Her delicately pointed eyes fix him with a disdainful stare, her upper lip curls contemptuously as she speaks, "You know why I'm here, scum!" Barely looking up, the gnarled figure of a Goblin grudgingly sneers an acknowledgement. Like a flash, the Elf swiftly reaches down to her side- the Greenskin's beady eyes flash with fear, until he sees what she has in her slender grasp- a sock! A very expensive one at that; monogrammed and made of silk. Brandishing it in his direction she declares, "Week 12, at the Vale." The Goblin mutters obscenities under his breath as he shoves a scabby green hand into the battered old satchel by his side. He pulls out a disgustingly soiled sock and waves it towards her, rasping, "Week 13 at da Swamp Dome, an you'ze gotta deal," At this, she nods reluctantly and the socks are quickly exchanged.

Scenes such will be repeated (sometimes for days on end) until finally, the schedule for the upcoming 2489-90 NAF season has been set. This is the Sock Exchange, the bizarre ritual that the NAF uses to organise each team's fixtures for the regular season.

As with most of the NAF's esoteric customs, the roots of the Sock Exchange go all the way back to the founding of the league over a century ago. It is derived from an obscure clause in the Book of Nuffle: 'Holey socks must be exchanged,' the less well known second part of

the clause goes on to say, 'check your store's returns policy,' but this bit made no sense to the first commissioner Roze-El when he translated it, so it is rarely ever mentioned.

Today, the regulations governing the Sock Exchange are pretty straightforward: Each team has 16 socks representing a regular season game. They arrange fixtures by swapping these socks with other teams during the meeting. The outcome of the Sock Exchange can make or break a team's season, which means all sorts of bribes, magic and dirty tricks take place. Take, for example, the Evil Gits, who went to the 2483 meeting determined to get a soft schedule and finally unseat the Darkside Cowboys as perpetual winners of the NFC Central Division. Being a bit short on funds, they couldn't afford bribes, spells or heavies, so, with despicable resourcefulness, they sent their very own Troll Blocker Smegk Braindeath to attend the meeting ordering him to thoroughly intimidate the stunty teams into handing over their socks. Smegk spent a wonderfully enjoyable afternoon threatening and roughing-up every Goblin and Halfling he could find, and consequently collected all the socks he needed.

When he arrived back at the Gits' HQ, he proudly presented the 16 socks he had menaced out of the poor stunties. But, his joy was short lived, when the Gits' furious head coach Slimy Stranglegut noticed the socks that Braindeath had presented him were nothing more than plain, ordinary woollen socks! The cretinous Troll had entered the wrong hall at the conference centre! Instead of the Sock-Exchange, he'd wandered into the annual 'Old World Hosiery Trade Fair', which is always coincides with the NAF's more famous sock-based meeting. In their absence, the NAF had assigned the Gits an eye wateringly difficult schedule. Needless to say, the 1-13-2 2483 season is not fondly remembered by the Gits' fans, although, their players did look snazzy wearing their brand new socks!

Grimwold Grimbreath

Since the untimely death of the NAF's killingest player, Engel 'the Exterminator' von Evilstein, the Dwarf Giants' captain Grimwold Grimbreath has made a compelling bid to claim his blood-stained crown (a bid made all the more impressive by the fact that he's done it without the use of automatic weapons... well, not many!)

Is Grimbreath really that deadly? Just ask the Lowdown Rats, who suffered a 16 player wipe out at the hands (and boots) of the 'Helmsmasher' back in '87; actually, you can't, as they're all dead! Or the fans of the Asgard Ravens, who made the mistake of launching a pitch invasion just as Grimwold was going to score a touchdown- the attendance that day was swiftly reduced by a third, thanks to one very angry Dwarf. You could even try asking his team-mates, although they'll probably be too frightened of Grimwold doing to them what he did to the freebooter who naively claimed one of Grimbreath's kills as his own last season.

In case you're thinking he's just a one-dimensional killing machine, we feel compelled to remind you, he's also very handy when he's got the ball. Blessed with a vice-like grip and, unusually for a Dwarf, a superb leaping ability, he is a multidimensional scoring threat, capable of bulldozing his way into the endzone or catching long passes, on the rare occasions the Giants take to the air.

Grimbreath's greatest moment on the pitch remains his starring role in their Blood Bowl

XXIV win against the Middenheim Marauders. On that day, Grimwold was the game's MVP and scored two touchdowns, his stellar performance confirmed him as one of the legendary Dwarf players, and vindicated new coach Gudrun Wolfric's controversial decision to rebuild the Giants around the rough-hewn Blitzer from Hammerton.

However, when Grimbreath himself was asked about his greatest triumph, his answer surprised many. It wasn't his Blood Bowl winner's medal, but his 2485 all-time record for most players killed by booting, which was, coincidentally, against the Lowdown Rats. Grimwold, as you might have guessed, is not a fan of Goblins!
