

Sports Kuerstrated
Finds Out Why...



In recent weeks, there has been much consternation amongst the sports fans of Ulthuan and Laurelorn, and it's not because the Albion Wanderers have just unveiled their dazzling new away kit, it's because the two most dominant Elf teams in the NAF, the Galadrieth Gladiators and Elfheim Eagles, have been struggling to assert themselves this season.

All this has been the cause of much rejoicing across Naggaroth, where the three of the NAF's four Dark Elf teams are having excellent campaigns. Nothing pleases the Druchii more than seeing their despised cousins losing ball games, well, nothing except ritual disembowelment and torture, but you get the idea! In the NFC Central, the Darkside Cowboys won their division at a canter, they're also the defending champions and are the red-hot favourites to retain the Blood Bowl trophy. In the AFC, Khain's Killers have surprised everyone in the Eastern Division, their titanic struggle for supremacy with the Chaos All-Stars has been one of their greatest ever seasons. Meanwhile, in the AFC West, the Dark Renegades are still in the hunt for the divisional title, and with the Eagles' erratic form, anything is possible. Even the Naggaroth Nightwings, who stand no chance of winning the AFC Central, may qualify for the Chaos Cup.

Although physically identical, the Dark Elves' success on the Blood Bowl field eclipses

the Elven teams' records by a massive margin. This is partly because the Elves eschewed the game for decades whereas the denizens of Naggaroth have been there since the beginning, over a century ago. However, the main reason is due to the fact that the Druchii are temperamentally better suited to a game that is premised on gratuitous violence and bloodshed. In comparison, Elf teams are appalled by all the blood, sweat and tears- not least because, it leaves unsightly stains on their shiny uniforms!

Of course, the Galadrieth Gladiators will argue that their successful running game proves there's more to the Elf teams than 'long bombs and hairspray'. However, there are limits to the Elves capacity to handle the more physical side of the game. These limits have been painfully exposed during this season, thanks to losing their mega star Blitzer Lucien Swift to a serious injury early on in the campaign. That said, they can still win the AFC West, which at the moment is a three-way battle the Eagles, Renegades Werewolves. If they do manage to qualify for the playoffs, who knows? They've certainly got the offensive fire power to breach even the toughest defences, but whether they can find the defensive steel to supplement their silky ball handling skills remains to be seen.

Bluebay Crammers (0-15) vs Dark Renegades (9-6)


